CORE FIRST AID TRAINING

First aid at work

3 days (18 hours) | 3-year certificate

This course comprehensively covers the practical skills needed by first aiders in most workplaces. Unless your workplace risk assessment indicates that the shorter *Emergency first aid at work* course covers all your needs and is sufficient for compliance with the regulations, this is essential training for your first aiders.

First aid at work requalification

2 days (12 hours) | 3-year certificate

This course is for first aiders who've previously completed the *First aid at work* course and have a certificate that is due to expire. It covers the same comprehensive content as the three-day course but in two days so prior first aid knowledge and skills are a prerequisite and delegates must have previously held a *First aid at work* qualification.

Emergency first aid at work

1 day (6 hours) | 3-year certificate

If your workplace risk assessment indicates that first aid training covering emergency protocols only is sufficient, this course will help you meet your regulatory requirements.

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ADDITIONAL FIRST AID TRAINING

Annual refresher

 $\frac{1}{2}$ day (3 hours) | No certificate

As an employer, you're responsible for ensuring your first aiders are competent and maintain their skills. The Health and Safety Executive strongly recommends that workplace first aiders attend a short refresher course once every year during the three years that their certificates are valid. This course will not re-validate certificates.

Paediatric first aid

2 days (12 hours) | 3-year certificate

This comprehensive paediatric first aid course is for professionals looking after infants and young children. It covers first aid from minor accidents to major emergencies and meets Ofsted Early Years and Childcare Register requirements.

Emergency paediatric first aid

1 day (6 hours) | 3-year certificate

This course focuses on emergency scenarios. It's designed in line with Ofsted Early Years and Childcare Register requirements to supplement cover in addition to first aiders who've qualified on the full two-day *Paediatric first aid* course.

Automated external defibrillation (AED)

½ day (3 hours) | 1-year certificate

Cardiac arrest can happen to anyone and for each minute that passes without defibrillation, the chance of survival falls by about 10%. This course requires no prior first aid knowledge and gives your employees the confidence to use a defibrillator and administer CPR in a life and death emergency.

AED requalification

2 hours | 1-year certficicate

This short course is for those who've previously attended AED training and need to re-validate their certificates.

Anaphylaxis first aid

1/2 day (3 hours) | 3-year certificate

Severe allergic reaction can kill without immediate first aid and the UK is one of the top countries in the world for instances of allergies. Chances are you have employees with serious allergies and this course, approved by Allergy UK, could be vital.

Medical gas administration*

½ day (4 hours) | 3-year certificate

Your risk assessment may indicate a need for training in the administration of oxygen and/or analgesic gas. This course covers the storage and administration of medical gas and equipment which can assist with resuscitation.

Healthcare workplace resuscitation*

2 hours | 3-year certificate

This short course is essential for healthcare professionals and others working in a healthcare setting. It ensures proficiency in performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on adults. Those working with children should undertake separate training, such as *Paediatric first aid*.

Basic sports first aid

1 day (6 hours) | 3-year certificate

This course focuses on the necessary first aid skills to deal with a wide range of sporting incidents from bone, muscle and joint injuries to treatment of an unresponsive casualty.

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TAKING OWNERSHIP OF MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Training for your leaders and employees is essential in helping to build a stronger, more resilient and productive workforce with an open, stigma-free culture that enables people to talk freely about mental health and find the right support when it's needed.

By embedding our suite of mental health and wellbeing training across your organisation, you can:

- drive positive, long term cultural change across your organisation as part of a robust policy
- ➤ give your people the tools to keep themselves and their colleagues healthy
- build greater resilience and a stronger, happier and focussed workforce
- > stop preventable mental health issues arising by building a supportive culture
- ➤ empower people with long-term mental health conditions to thrive at work
- encourage and help people to access support when it's needed, for a faster and full recovery
- ➤ significantly reduce the costs associated with mental ill health.

How to get started

A Government commissioned report* outlines six core standards, giving a framework for a set of actions that can be quickly implemented:

1. Produce, implement and communicate a mental health at work plan

Your plan should outline the approach to understanding, improving, protecting and monitoring the mental health of all employees, understanding the risks and building resilience. It should include training, and the support available to those who need it.

2. Develop mental health awareness among employees

Appointing trained employee Mental Health Champions and Mental Health First Aiders to offer peer support, and providing training for employees to develop their knowledge, understanding and resilience will help to overcome the stigma around mental health and build a stronger, more resilient workforce.

3. Encourage open conversations about mental health and the support available

This is about creating an environment in which employees feel able to talk openly without judgement. Consider appropriate training for all your line managers and team leaders so they have the understanding, skills and confidence to hold appropriate conversations.

4. Provide employees with good working conditions

Good working conditions where all occupational physical and mental health risks are assessed and appropriate measures implemented will allow everyone to get on in work and thrive. When employees are healthy and happy to be at work, everyone benefits.

5. Promote effective people management

Training in resilience building, understanding mental ill health, offering appropriate support and ensuring their own behaviours are positive is an excellent way to approach better people management. It's also vital that people who've been absent from work have a well-managed return.

6. Routinely monitor employee mental health and wellbeing

This is a key part of good occupational health and wellbeing management and should form part of your workplace wellbeing plan. Sickness and absence data can be used to spot problems and focus support. Employee surveys, mood trackers and other tools can help to improve communication and understanding of the risks.

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MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING



Our MHFA courses have been developed by and in partnership with Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) England.

Adult mental health first aid 2 days

Training for Mental Health First Aiders

In the same way as learning physical first aid, MHFA teaches people how to recognise those crucial warning signs of mental ill health and feel confident to guide someone to appropriate support.

Mental health first aiders are trained to:

- > spot the early signs and symptoms of mental ill health
- > start a supportive, non-judgemental conversation
- > assess the risk
- encourage the person to access appropriate professional support or self-help strategies
- > escalate to the appropriate emergency services, if necessary
- ➤ maintain confidentiality as appropriate
- > complete critical incident documents as and when necessary
- > protect themselves while performing their role.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive a Mental Health First Aider certificate.

Adult mental health first aid 1 day

Training for Mental Health First Aid Champions

MHFA Champions play a key role in overcoming the stigma around mental health and creating a positive and open working culture.

Training will give MHFA champions:

- > an understanding of common mental health issues
- knowledge and confidence to advocate for mental health awareness
- ➤ ability to spot signs of mental ill health
- skills to support positive wellbeing.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive a Mental Health First Aid Champion certificate.

Adult mental health first aid 1/2 day

Training for everyone in Mental Health First Aid Awareness

This four-hour session will provide an understanding of what mental health is and how to challenge stigma. This course is ideal for helping to raise mental health awareness and drive cultural change across your organisation. It will give people the skills to support their own and others' positive wellbeing in the workplace.

What your employees will learn on the course:

- > an understanding of what mental health is
- ➤ factors which affect mental health
- ➤ an overview of common mental health conditions and how to spot their signs
- ➤ an understanding of how to support mental health in the workplace.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive a *Mental Health Aware* certificate.

Youth mental health first aid 2 days

Training for Youth Mental Health First Aiders

This course is for anyone who works with or supports young people aged 8-18, such as school staff and youth workers. Certificate holders will be given the skills to spot the triggers of various mental health issues, the confidence to reassure and support a young person in distress, as well as supporting a young person with a long-term mental health issue and provide guidance to further help if required.

Youth Mental Health First Aiders are trained to do the same things as an Adult Mental Health First Aider (see top-left), but training is geared towards the very specific mental health needs of younger people.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive a Youth Mental Health First Aider certificate.



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WELLBEING AND RESILIENCE TRAINING

We've teamed up with IOSH and The Wellbeing Project to offer courses to help you manage health and wellbeing, and build resilience across your organisation.

Resilient managers 1 day



Training for line managers and team leaders

This course provides those who manage or lead others with practical strategies, tactics and tools to confidently lead wellbeing conversations, respond appropriately, nurture a good working environment and proactively support the whole team.

What you will learn on the course:

- > the benefits of leading and enabling your staff wellbeing
- > recognising the early warning signs of ill health
- > skills to proactively support individuals who may be struggling
- > how to approach wellbeing conversations with confidence.

Resilient you 1 day



Training for everyone

This course is designed for everyone in your workforce. It enables people to understand what resilience is and how to build and maximise it in themselves. Training will reduce the risk of burnout and illness by introducing key principles and healthy boundaries.

What your employees will learn on the course:

- ➤ how to build and maximise your own resilience
- ➤ how to reduce the risk of burnout and illness by embracing some key principles
- ➤ knowledge to access inner drive, confidence and think positively
- > tools to face the future with optimism.

IOSH managing occupational health and wellbeing 1 day



Training for leaders and managers

This course is designed to give leaders and line managers the confidence, knowledge and skills to manage the health and wellbeing of their employees. 


